BANKS NEVER ASK THAT!

Protect yourself! Watch for the following red flags of phishing in emails, phone calls or text messages

1. An email that appears to be from the bank asks you to click on a link you weren't expecting to receive.
2. An email that appears to be from the bank has an attachment you weren't expecting to receive.
3. The person contacting you uses urgent or fear-inducing language.
4. The person contacting you is requesting personal information like PIN numbers, passwords or social security numbers.
5. The person contacting you is pressuring you to log into or send money with payments apps.
